Talking Points

- o I understand that you've got these closed hearings going on now for the next few days.
- o I want to make sure that you bring out through your examination of witnesses or prepared statements what we discussed in my office a couple of weeks ago when you were here with Sen. Sanford. Both told me in no uncertain terms that you were convinced that the President was not in Paris in October 1980 and that there is no credible evidence that indicates he was.
- o This is important and it must be said clearly for the record. We cannot let something this important left hanging.
