- C. Privilege. No special rules, but no desire to assert it. Make maximum use of "access-only" approaches for sensitive/highly classified documents. **[ASK ED TO DESCRIBE STATE DEPARTMENT THREE-TIER APPROACH -- WE SHOULD ALL BE CONSISTENT]**
- D. Classification Review.
 - **ISSUE: Should producing agency be responsible to identify and protect interagency equities? Or should we require interagency review prior to production?**
- E. Tracking of Expenditures.
 - **[Bob Damus Has Volunteered For This Previously - Ask Status]**
 - Important to Do. Agency Responsibility.
 - FOIA Report A Good Model -- Congress Should Be "Charged" What It Has Provided By Law For The People To Be Charged.
- IV. White House Counsel Responsibilities.
 - A. Serve as focal point within White House for information/analysis regarding ongoing investigations.
 - B. Chair Interagency Working Group to monitor ongoing investigations and support integrated assessments and responses as necessary. **[AND INTERAGENCY SECURITY REVIEW?]**
 - C. Liaison with the Archivist and representatives of former Presidents Reagan and Carter regarding any privilege issues pertaining to their Presidential records.
