true copy of the Judgment of the Superior Court of New York acquitting me of all charges together with a copy of the Subpoenae issued from the United States Congress requiring my attendance before that body for the purposes of giving evidence.

(d) Deportation from the United States:-

Whilst I was in the United States of America it came to my attention that the United States Attorney General was attempting to arrange my deportation. I have no first hand knowledge of this attempt but from sources close to me I have no reason to believe that such attempt was not made.

(e) Visits by Israeli authorities to family members
in Israel:-

I am informed by my mother who resides in Tel Aviv that she was visited by members of Shin Bet during the course of the hearing before the Federal Superior Court and subsequently before the United States Congress. Shin Bet is the Israeli Secret Police and it is not, from my knowledge of the workings of the Israeli Intelligence Services, standard practice for them to visit members of the community other than for the purposes of the obtaining of information. was informed by my mother and believe that members of Shin Bet tried to convince my mother that it would be in my best interests to plead guilty to all charges before the Federal Superior Court if I wished to avoid prosecution in My mother is travelling to Australia this week and will be available to provide further information as to the nature of those investigations.

(f) Israeli passport:-

The only passport on which I am able to travel is the passport issued by the Israeli government. I believe that if I return to Israel that passport would be revoked and I would be charged with offences under the Official Secrets Act. In that regard I believe that my ability to continue to travel on that Israeli passport may ultimately be revoked therefore rendering me stateless and obliged to return to Israel. If I return to Israel I will be prosecuted and from my experience such proceedings are held "in camera".
