Defendants indicating that distributions were made to his former spouse (who is an

officer of both Plaintiffs), even though the distributions should have been made to

both Defendant and his former spouse jointly. Defendant is raising what appears

Defendant. Plaintiffs' counsel argued that distributions were not due because

Defendant's joint interest in Emerging Europe Growth Fund, L.P. is pledged as

security against loans taken by Defendant and his former spouse. However, those

loans are not owed to the partnership, but to another entity, and, in any event, there

has been no accounting of payments to the loan holder. This matter may result in

counterclaims being raised in this action.
